eduroam is a secure Wi-Fi network offered by various research and educational communities.



Connect to eduroam

Windows, macOS, and iOS

1. Access your Wi-Fi settings

- Windows



- macOS



- o iOS



2. Select **eduroam** from the list of wireless networks
3. Enter your **College email** and **password**
4. If prompted, click **Connect** or **Trust Certificate**

Android

1. Open **Settings**
2. Select **Connections > Wi-Fi**
3. Tap **eduroam**
4. Enter the following:
 - o Identity: **your College email**
 - o Password: **your College password**
 - o CA certificate: **Use system certificates**
 - o Domain: **brynmawr.edu**
5. Tap **Connect**

Attention: If you are unable to connect or see different, or missing, settings.

ChromeOS

1. In the bottom-right corner, click the **Wi-Fi icon** 
2. Select **eduroam** from the list of wireless networks
3. Enter the following:
 - o Security: **EAP**
 - o EAP Method: **PEAP**
 - o EAP phase 2 authentication: **MSCHAPV2**
 - o Server CA certificate: **default**
 - o Subject match: **(leave blank)**
 - o Subject alternative name match: **(leave blank)**
 - o Domain suffix match: **brynmawr.edu**
 - o Identity: **your College email**
 - o Password: **your College password**
4. Click **Connect**
