Domain of One's Own: Get started

Early in the 20th century, Virginia Woolf used the phrase "a room of one's own", to imagine the literal and figurative space women needed to become writers. The web-hosting platform, Domain of One's Own (DOO), was designed to give faculty, students, and staff the 21st century equivalent: a digital domain where they can host web sites and web apps, develop digital competencies and pursue digital scholarship or creative work.

Before you start, you will need access to the following:

- an active Bryn Mawr College username and password
- Haverford students, faculty, and staff can sign up for a Haverford Sites domain instead
- Swarthmore students, faculty, and staff can sign up for a Digital Swarthmore domain instead

Sign up for a domain

- 1. In a web browser, go to digital.brynmawr.edu [].
- 2. Click Get Started.



- 3. Log in using your Bryn Mawr username and password.
- 4. Under Choose Your Domain, type a proposed name into the box provided and clickContinue [].

Once your domain is created, you will see the Dashboard or CPanel you will use to manage it.

What domain name should I use?

Your domain name is the web address -- e.g., **domainname.digital.brynmawr.edu --** where you will build a digital presence. Here are some things to consider when creating it.

You have **complete control over** and **complete responsibility for** your digital.brynmawr.edu domain space. Here's more information about what that entails.

cPanel: Your domain dashboard

Your Domain of One's **Dashboard** or "cPanel" is a central interface for managing your domain and any applications or files you install there.

- To access your Dashboard in the future, go to digital.brynmawr.edu
 , click Dashboard, and log in with
 your college credentials.
- One of the easiest ways to build a website is toinstall an application. Commonly used applications include:
 - WordPress for blogs and basic websites.
 - Omeka for digital collections and exhibitions based on library and archival resources.
 - Grav for minimal computing, Markdown-based websites that can integrate with GitHub.
 - Scalar for non-linear digital books and publishing.
 - Click All Applications to see additional open-source applications that can be installed through CPanel, including TRU Collector or TRU Writer for crowd-sourced image collecting or writing.
