

Panopto: Quizzes

Panopto enables video **Creators** to add quiz questions at any point in a recording. This can be a good way to keep students engaged and measure their understanding of a recording's content.

Before you start, you will need:

- A **Creator role** in your course folder within Bryn Mawr's Panopto site

Setting up a Panopto Quiz

1. Find the video to which you want to add a quiz and click **Edit**.
2. Move your recording to the time where you want to add a quiz question.
3. Select **Quizzes > Add a Quiz**.
4. Your primary video feed will move to the side and be replaced by the input screen for a quiz question.

5. Enter the following details for your question:
 - **Question (Question Title for the Fill in The Blank question type):** the text of your question.
 - **Select:** this is where you choose your question type. You can choose **True/False, Multiple Choice, Multiple Select, or Fill in The Blank**.
 - **Answer 1, Answer 2:** List your answer options. Click **Add answer...** if you want to add more options (for the **Fill in The Blank** question type you won't put in answers, but instead add your prompt in the **Question** field).
 - **Correct answer explanation (optional):** provide the correct answer to viewers after they've submitted their answers.

6. Click **Add a Question** to add more questions at this moment in the video. Otherwise, select **Done**.
7. This will take you to a new page where you can make final edits to your question:

- **Quiz Position** lets you change the point in the video when this questions appears.
- **Allow viewers to retake this quiz:** can be checked or unchecked.
- **Show grade after taking this quiz :** can be checked or unchecked. If checked, you can also choose whether to **Allow review of correct answers and explanations**.
- **Block advancing in the video until answering this quiz:** can be checked or unchecked. Even if checked, however, this feature will turn off once a viewer has finished all quiz questions.
- **Questions:** use this to reorder and delete questions

8. Click **Finish** when done.

As viewers begin taking your quiz, you can view their results by selecting **Settings** ⚙️ on the video where you've added the quiz. A pop-menu will open; select the **Quiz Results** tab within it. From this page, you can select **Download** to collect your results in a CSV.

Caution: Students can only answer Panopto quiz questions if they are logged into Bryn Mawr's Panopto site. Direct them to [Panopto: Get and log into your account](#) if they're having login issues.

Connect a Panopto Quiz to the Moodle Gradebook (Optional)

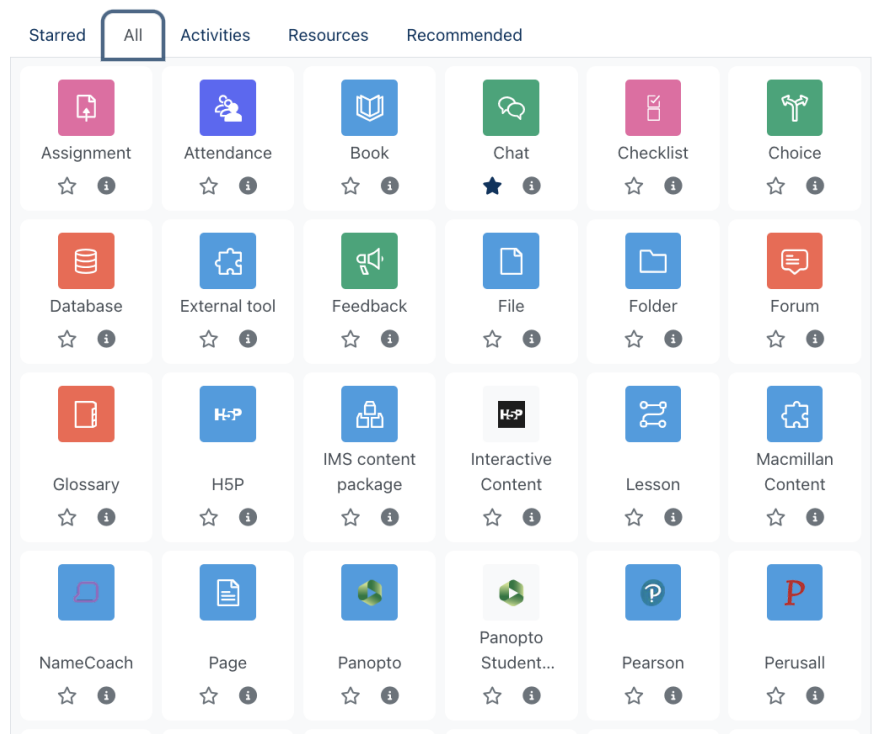
Before you start, you may need access to the following:

- an existing Quiz in a Panopto video

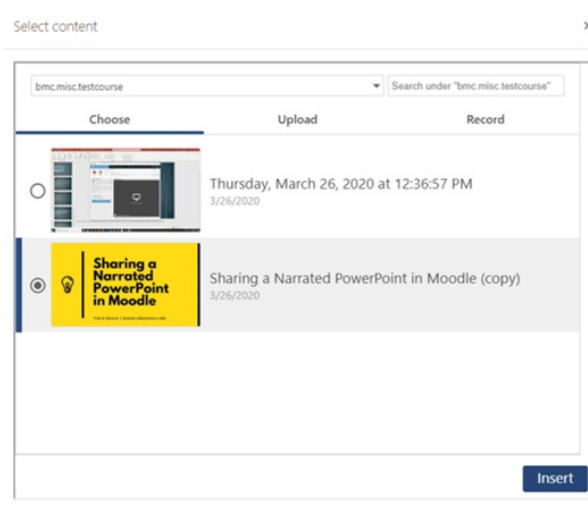
- the Panopto video to be connected to your course in Moodle. See [Panopto: Add the Panopto block to a Moodle course](#) if you need help connecting your Moodle course with its Panopto folder.

To connect a Panopto quiz to your Moodle grabeook, you will have to add the Panopto activity to the Moodle course:

1. Navigate to the course in which you'd like to integrate a Panopto quiz and turn on **Edit Mode**.
2. Click on **Add an Activity or Resource**. From the options, choose **Panopto**.



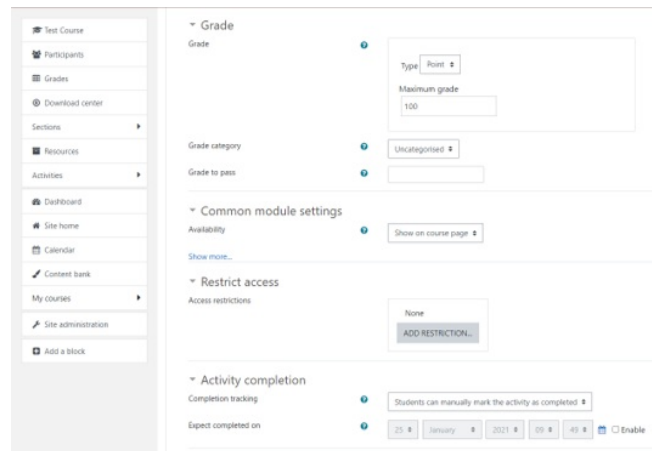
3. Click **Select Content** and choose the video in Panopto to which you've already added a quiz. When you've made your choice, click **Insert**. The activity name will pre-populate with your video's title; you can edit this if you like.



4. Under **Privacy**, make sure all three boxes are checked: **Share launcher's name with the tool**, **Share launcher's email with the tool**, and **Accept grades from the tool**. This will ensure that student data

feeds from Panopto to Moodle.

5. Under **Grade**, you can set a point value for the quiz grade and choose a Grade category.
6. You can also control other common Moodle activity settings, such as **Restrict access** and **Activity completion**, if you'd like.



7. Once you have the settings you want, hit the **Save and Display** button at the bottom of the screen.

Once students starting taking the the quiz, you can view their grades by clicking on **Grades** in your course-level menu. You will see an entry for the Panopto Quiz activity and grades for students who have completed the in-video quiz.
