BeeLine Reader [□](#) supports **reading long blocks of text online** by **adding an eye-guiding color gradient** to help reduce eye fatigue and increase reading speed. It is available as a **Chrome or Firefox browser extension** [□](#) and you can use it to read online documents on any device that supports these browsers.

Before you begin, you will need:

- A Bryn Mawr College email address and password.

1. Install the BeeLine Reader plugin for [Chrome](#) [□](#) or [Firefox](#).

2. Register your browser on Bryn Mawr College's subscription:
