


# Moodle: Get accessible alternative formats for course materials

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Moodle course participants can use the new **Yuja Panorama** integration with Moodle to **convert course documents and web pages to alternative accessible formats** such as Immersive Reader, Audio Podcast, and Braille.

**Before you start**, you will need to be:

- Enrolled as a participant in a Bryn Mawr College Moodle course (with any role)

1. Click the  (Alternative formats) icon next to any course document or activities to open a menu of alternative format options.

2. **Choose a format**, then click **View** or **Download**.
