Tip: Restart your computer often


Windows

Updates on Windows devices are split between Dell and Windows updates.


- Dell: Firmware and driver updates fundamental to the basic functions of your device
- Windows: Security patches and software improvements

Dell updates


- 1. Click the Windows Search bar
- 2. Type in and click on Dell Command Update



3. Click Check



4. Select all available updates and click Install




5. **Wait some time** for the updates to install Your computer may restart a few times.

- 7. Repeat Steps 1-6 until no new updates are available


Windows updates

- 2. Type in and click on Check for updates






