- 2. Ask for an item at Canaday Circulation desk during open hours to check it out.
 - Equipment is available on a first-come, first-served basis.
 - Loans are for 7 days and non-renewable.
 - You will be required to sign aloan agreement form before taking possession of the equipment.
 Please read the form to ensure that you understand the terms of the loan.
- 3. Before you return a device, check that:
 - You have downloaded and deleted personal files if relevant (for example, pictures on a digital camera).
 - You have everything named in the contents list inside the bag: cords, peripherals, media. Staff
 will check returned equipment to ensure it still works and all accessories have been returned;
 borrowers are responsible for loss or damage.
- 4. **Return equipment to the Canaday Circulation Desk** during open hours. Do **not** leave it in the Book Drop outside of Canaday or the circulation desks at Carpenter or Collier Libraries.
