

MyOpenMath: Add open education math resources to your Moodle course

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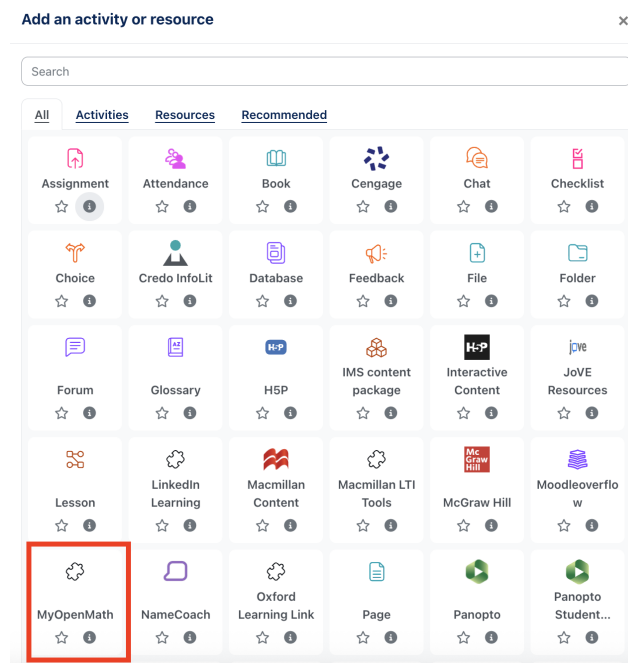
MyOpenMath is a tool for open educational resources (OER's) on mathematics. This article explains how to add **MyOpenMath** materials to your course. 📖

Before you start, you will need:

- An **Instructor of record** or **Non-editing teacher role** in a Bryn Mawr Moodle course

Add Credo resources to Moodle

1. Log into your Moodle course and switch **Edit Mode** on.
2. Click + **Add an activity or resource** in the section where you want to put MyOpenMath materials.
3. Click the **All** tab, then click **MyOpenMath**.



4. A new page will open that's titled **Add External Tool**. Click the **Select Content** button.
5. A new pop-up menu will open showing the different MyOpenMath assessments available to add to your course. Select the content what you want to add, then click **Submit**.

Note: Only assessments can be added to Moodle through the LTI tool. Other MyOpenMath content, such as instructional texts, can be added as files to Moodle courses. See [Moodle: Add files and folders to a course](#) for details.

5. The pop-up menu will close and the name of the content you picked will appear in the **Activity name** field within the **New External tool** page.
6. Click **Save and return to course**.

Any activities you selected will now appear in their specified section.
