MyOpenMath: Add open education math resources to your Moodle course


MyOpenMath is a tool for open educational resources (OER's) on mathematics. This article explains how to add MyOpenMath materials to your course.

Before you start, you will need:

An Instructor of record or Non-editing teacher role in a Bryn Mawr Moodle course


Add MyOpenMath resources to Moodle

- 1. Log into your Moodle course and switch Edit Mode on.
- 2. Click + Add content > Add an activity or resource in the section where you want to put MyOpenMath materials.
- 3. Click the All tab, then click MyOpenMath.



- 4. A new page will open that's titled Add External Tool. Click the Select Content button.
- 5. A new pop-up menu will open showing the different MyOpenMath assessments available to add to

your course. Select the content what you want to add, then click Submit.



Note: Only assessments can be added to Moodle through the LTI tool. Other MyOpenMath content, such as instructional texts, can be added as files to Moodle courses. See Moodle: Add files and folders to a course for details.

- 5. The pop-up menu will close and the name of the content you picked will appear in the **Activity** name field within the **New External tool** page.
- 6. Click Save and return to course.

Any activities you selected will now appear in their specified section.
